## **GROVE ELECTED THIRD VICE PRESIDENT OF AIC**

**INDIANAPOLIS** – Randolph County Treasurer Jane Grove was elected to the position of Third Vice President of the Association of Indiana Counties (AIC) Board of Directors. She will begin her term November 1. Board elections were held during the AIC's Annual Conference in Marion County in September.

"It is an honor to be elected and to serve with the Association of Indiana Counties," Grove said. "As I assume my position, I will work with the Board of Directors to represent the interests of county government in the General Assembly. Also, I will be working to bring education and support to county officials and employees."

Grove is currently serving her second year as Randolph County Treasurer. Previously, she served as the East Central District President for the AIC.

The AIC Board of Directors sets policies and legislative goals for the Association. The AIC's Board of Directors met with AIC Legislative Committee members during the AIC's Annual Conference in September and adopted its 2013 legislative platform.

The Association of Indiana Counties, Inc. is a nonprofit organization that was established in 1957 for the betterment of county government. The various functions of the AIC include lobbying the Indiana General Assembly on behalf of counties, serving as liaison among counties, state and federal agencies as well as providing technical assistance and training to county officials and employees.
