INTRODUCTION

The Association of Indiana Counties 2015 County Factbook is produced by the AIC concerning employee compensation and fiscal management of Indiana county governments. This publication contains data regarding: annual wages and fringe benefits of employees, department staffing and appropriations, local option taxes, county tax rates and levies, and county highway information.

In April of 2015, a questionnaire requesting salary and fringe benefit information for elected officials and the most typical job positions in county government was emailed to county auditors.

Salary data was compiled according to each employee group (sheriff's department, professional/administrative, labor/trades/crafts, etc.) and grouped according to population by county. Fringe benefits were compiled in two employee groups, sheriff's department employees and other county employees. All salaries are reported on an annual, full-time basis unless otherwise specified. Abbreviations used are explained on the reverse of each section divider. Symbols may be used in various sections to represent information that needs clarification. Monetary amounts are often rounded to the nearest dollar. Percentages are also rounded.

Caution should be used in making parallels between the same job position in different counties since duties, skills and experience may vary widely. Also, there are great variances in economic conditions, proximity to large cities, labor supply and demand and finally, the financial ability of a county to provide certain compensation.

A county's ability to pay may be indicated to some degree by population, tax rates, assessed valuation, and per capita income. Data reported for these sections was obtained from the United States Census Bureau, Bureau of Motor Vehicles, Department of Local Government Finance, State Board of Tax Commissioners, Indiana Department of Transportation, Purdue University, and Legislative Services Agency.
